



CEDAR VALLEY COLLEGE HOSTS APRIL 15 GRAND OPENING FOR NEW SCIENCE, VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY, ALLIED HEALTH BUILDING

Award-winning 108,000 sq. ft. facility pending LEED Certification

What:

Grand opening for the award-winning Science, Veterinary Technology, Allied Health Building. Dr. Jennifer Wimbish, President of Cedar Valley College, will deliver short opening remarks.

Cutting the ribbon to officially open this \$30.19 million facility will be Dr. Jennifer Wimbish and Dr. Wright Lassiter, Chancellor of the Dallas County Community College District. This 108,000 square foot facility incorporates several “green” principles in its design—daylighting, shading, reduced infiltration and recycled jeans used as insulation. Students will also benefit from experiences in the outdoor learning center.
